

# The New Jersey Legion of Honor Preceptory Scholarship

Based in a philanthropic drive to provide the tools necessary for our youth to succeed in their future endeavors; and based on the idea of a strong education being a keystone for future success in their lives, it has been decided by The New Jersey Legion of Honor Preceptory to reaffirm our commitment to our youth by establishing a scholarship award that provides both a means and incentive for future generations to succeed.

## **ELIGIBILITY**

A one-time undergraduate scholarship will be awarded to an active DeMolay who has satisfactorily completed the requirements for high school graduation, has been accepted in an accredited college, university or community college and has not yet completed his 2<sup>nd</sup> year of such an institution at the time of the application deadline. If the applicant has worked following his high school graduation, he must apply for this scholarship prior to his twenty-second birthday.

The committee will consider the applicant's academic achievement, financial need, character, and service to others in awarding this scholarship. A transcript of the applicant's high school record is required and must be included with the application. All questions on the application **MUST** be completed.

## **AWARD**

One scholarship of \$500 will be awarded and paid directly to the individual to pay for textbooks or related educational expenses necessary to pursue an education at an institution of higher learning.

## **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REQUIRED**

In addition to this form we will require two "essays:"

The first will be a brief description of what the applicant hopes to achieve by attending college/a school of higher education. This may include why they chose the major they are pursuing, or what they intend to do with their degree.

The second will require a description of the financial need for the scholarship. This may include an overview of the family finances, the fact that the student is paying their own way through college, or what other information may be needed to demonstrate the "need" portion of the application.

## **ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTATION**

In addition to the application, the following documents will also be required:

School transcript - Either from high school or college career to date. An applicant who has only completed one year of college will be required to provide both a high school and college transcript.

College acceptance letter (or other evidence of continuing education/college enrollment)

Federal "Student Aid Report" – This is the report received after the applicant completes the Free Application For Student Aid (FAFSA).

## APPROVAL AND DISBURSEMENT

Once the applications have been received, they will be reviewed and “ranked” based on merit and need by the Commander of the Legion of Honor Preceptory and his committee. The committee will consist of three members for a total review board of three (3) including the DeMolay Executive Officer. A summary of each application and the Commander along with the committee’s reasons for the ranking will be prepared along with a recommendation for the recipients. Funds will be disbursed directly to the individual for deposit in the recipient’s account as stated previously.
