Eric L. Gonzales 47 of Keyport died suddenly on Wednesday, July 20, 2002 at his residence. Born in Passaic, Eric resided in Clifton before moving to Keyport 14 years ago.

A 1992 graduate of Clifton High School and a 1996 graduate of the Computer Learning Center, Eric was employed as a Computer Support Specialist for ADP in Roseland for 24 years before becoming a Project Manager with NAVA in Washington, DC a year ago.

He is a 26 year member of Clifton Masonic Lodge #203 who served as their Master in 2011 and is also a member of the Valley of Northern NJ Scottish Rite and Salaam Shriners both in Whippany.
